

Risk Management Committee / Review of Injuries

Dates Reviewed: November 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019

1. Injury: Strain to Shoulder

Description of Accident: Employee was working on upper rear door hinge mount while on a short ladder. The step ladder was placed parallel to the door and was working over his left shoulder. Employee felt a pull in his shoulder.

Corrective Measures: position ladder as to not work off the side of the ladder.

2. Injury: Cut and Broken Thumb

Description of Accident: Employee was removing drive shaft. Drive shaft had pressure on it from transmission being in stuck in gear. The drive shaft spun and kicked sideways and smashed thumb between drive shaft and exhaust.

Corrective Measures: Jack up drive shaft and release brakes to release the pressure from drive shaft.

3. Injury: Bruise to Right Hand

Description of Accident: Employee was installing the rear differential in a Kenworth T800. Space was limited due to heavy suspension. There was not enough room for the gray transmission jack. The forklift was used to support the differential using straps. The strap slipped causing the differential to fall on the floor catching the end of the right hand.

Corrective Measures: Remove brake chambers so jack will fit under the truck. Ask for assistance if necessary.

4. Injury: Displacement of ring finger resulting in a broken bone

Description of Accident: Employee unbolted hitch receiver. While employee was pulling down and the receiver was heavier on one side. Hand slipped on receiver – injuring it.

Corrective Measure: Do not take shortcuts. Use a jack to prevent slipping or ask for assistance.

Please make sure all injuries are reported to AccidentsAndInjuries@starlease.com in a timely manner. Go over with all shifts where the Injury reports are kept so they are accessible. Injury reports should be completed and turned in even if no medical treatment is given.

Our goal is for employees to punch out in the same condition that they came into work.
