

Risk Management Committee / Review of Injuries

Dates Reviewed: December 10, 2020 to January 13, 2021

Employee Injuries	
Injury Type	Laceration to left index finger
Description of Accident	After an electrical repair employee was covering the wires and cut his finger. The employee used a retractable razor blade and cut parallel to finger. The blade cut the finger the employee went to cut.
Corrective Measures	Incorrect tool use. Employee should have used a pair of cutting pliers instead of using knife.
Employee Vehicle Accidents	
Type of Accident	Fixed Object Collision
Description of Accident	Service truck was parked next to dumpster. Employee had to back at angle to pull into shop. Employee struck the dumpster while backing.
Corrective Measures	Be aware of your surroundings. Walk around the unit before getting into the cab.
Type of Accident	Fixed Object Collision
Description of Accident	While backing a unit out of the garage, the exhaust struck the door.
Corrective Measures	Pay attention to details. Check to make sure all the door is all the way up. Check and double check to make sure doors are completely open when pulling in and out of shop.
	Does your branch have a policy that the doors should be all the way up or down – no doors partially left open/closed?
Type of Accident	Fixed Object Collision
Description of Accident	Employee was backing a trailer into a parking spot. While backing, employee did not see a hitch that was extended from the trailer, striking it. Damage to two door panels of the trailer.
Corrective Measures	Pay attention while backing up. GET OUT AND LOOK FOR ANY OBSTACLES. If necessary, ask for assistance.
Type of Accident	Employee Error
Description of Accident	While driving a unit back to customer, the trailer disconnected from the tractor in the customer's parking lot. Trailer skidded and before stopping in the grass
Corrective Measures	Employees need to make sure the 5 th wheel is securely latched using a flashlight if necessary. Also a tug test should be completed before moving the equipment.
	More to come on this. Please make sure you discuss with all employees on the proper way to ensure a tractor/trailer are properly secured.
Type of Accident	Fixed Object Collision
Description of Accident	While attempting to move a tractor out of the fuel island, struck the yellow cement pylon with the truck.
Corrective Measures	Employees should watch mirrors, slow down and move equipment cautiously.

Please make sure all injuries are reported to AccidentsAndInjuries@starlease.com in a timely manner. Go over with all shifts where the Injury reports are kept so they are accessible. Injury reports should be completed and turned in even if no medical treatment is given.

Our goal is for employees to punch out in the same condition that they came into work.
